
Student Guide

Welcome to Heifer's Read to Feed Beanstack website. Beanstack is a web-based reading challenge software and we've partnered with them to make it a little more fun to read for school or for yourself!

With this site, you can track your reading minutes, write book reviews, and participate in fun activities to earn digital streaks and badges!

How to I log my reading?

When you log in, you will come to your homepage.




There are a couple of ways to log your reading. You can set a reading timer or you can log minutes. We'll talk about Completing an Activity in a moment.

[Start a Reading Timer](#)


If you choose "Start a Reading Timer", it will take you to a screen that looks like this, which is a stopwatch.



Simply Click "Start Reading" and the timer will start. It's important NOT TO LEAVE this screen, otherwise your timer will stop.



Once you have your time logged in and your done reading, simply hit "I'm Done Reading"



You'll see this screen where you select the day you read:


Once you've logged your reading, hit the small "X" in the upper right hand of your screen to return to your reading homepage.

## Digital Rewards

The best part about Heifer Beanstack site is the awards you can achieve simply by logging your reading. You can create streaks, earn badges and achievements by simply reading or doing simple activities.

### Streaks

A streak is when you log more than one day in a row. It works just like another popular phone app that records 'streaks' with your friends by sending them short messages/pics daily.



In the example above, "Paul" has read 4 days in a row so now he has a 'streak'. The goal is to read every day to keep your streak intact.

### All Reading Logged

Click on the tab that says "All Reading Logged" and you'll see a list of books that you've read along with the time you've read them.

Badges



## Signing Out
