## About the Programme

The Green Dairy Investment Programme aims to transform existing dairy hubs into resilient, inclusive, and economically viable platforms by promoting green agribusiness investments and technologies, while supporting the development of a 10-year dairy sustainability roadmap to guide green investment.

This programme will support beneficiaries to adopt climate-smart practices in dairy production, and train and support farmers to adopt advanced dairy technologies and best practices. This support to the dairy sector will chart a green investment pathway for the sector, strengthen producer organizations and dairy processors, increase milk yields and improve the quality of dairy products and will also reduce greenhouse gas emissions along the dairy value chain.

## Objectives of the Programme

1



Develop a 10-year dairy sustainability roadmap aligned with national climate goals to guide green investments and policy integration

2



Promote adoption of climate-smart practices (water-efficient systems, improved breeding, renewable energy), boosting farmer productivity and resilience

3



Scale solar-powered cold chains at milk collection centers, reducing post-harvest losses by 10% and expanding their access to formal markets

4



Optimize processor capacity utilization to 20% from their current capacity through farmer-producer partnerships

5



Transform dairy hubs by providing Business Development Services (BDS) through digitized tools, financial linkages and operational benchmarking

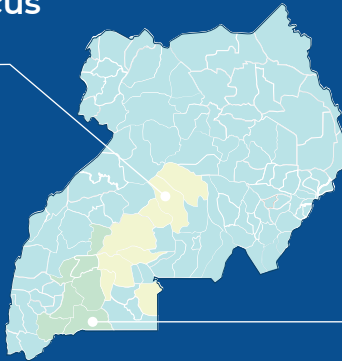
