


BACKGROUND

The agricultural sector in Africa, employing around 60% of the workforce, is crucial for growth and job creation, especially for the continent's large youth population. Recognizing this, Heifer International launched the AYuTe Africa NextGen initiative in 2021 to drive agribusiness innovation.

This program supports young African entrepreneurs in developing agritech solutions to address smallholder farmers' challenges, providing necessary incubation and financing. The AYuTe Africa Challenge, an annual competition under this initiative, awards grants and offers ongoing support and mentorship to strong growth stage agritech innovators.

By positioning agriculture as a tech-driven, aspirational career, AYuTe aims to make the sector more appealing to the next generation and catalyze agricultural transformation across Africa.


NATIONAL AYuTe
